## THE DOORBELL YOU'VE BEEN WAITING FOR.

Nest Hello lets customers know who's there, so they never miss a thing. It replaces an existing wired doorbell and delivers HD video and bright, crisp images, even at night. It's designed to show them everything at their doorstep – people head to toe or packages on the ground. And with 24/7 streaming, customers can check in anytime.<sup>1</sup>

## TOP FEATURES

HD

### Video designed for the front door

Provides HD video and 4:3 aspect ratio that lets customer see people head to toe.

With High-Dynamic-Range (HDR) imaging, they can see key details, even in uneven light, while Night Vision lets them see when it's dark.



### Alerts that matter

Nest Hello can detect a person and send customers an alert with a picture of what happened — even no one rings the bell.

A Nest Aware subscription adds familiar face alerts and Activity Zones to give customers the alerts they want.<sup>2</sup>



### Know who's at the door

Check what's happening at the front door anytime using the Nest app. Review the 3-hour snapshot history to see key moments.

Upgrade to Nest Aware to add 24/7 continuous cloud video recording so customers can review video of important moments and visitors they missed.



### Talk to Guests

Have a natural conversation using HD Talk + Listen. Echo and ambient noise cancellation make sure customers hear clearly.

Customers can use the app to choose from a list of pre-recorded responses that will be spoken by Nest Hello to quickly and effortlessly answer visitors.

## THOUGHTFUL DESIGN

### Quiet Time

Quiet Time lets customers turn off their chime from the Nest app, while still receiving notifications. So they don't wake up the baby or disturb their pets.<sup>3</sup>

### Easy Inside and Out

A light ring will show guests the button.

Nest Hello can sound an alert on Google Home devices around the home. And with Nest Aware, Google Home can even tell customers who's at the door.

### Busy Professional

- Nest Hello is fully powered to stream 24/7. It can even recognize a person and send them a special alert so they know which notifications are most important and which to ignore.
- With HD Talk and Listen they can answer the doorbell from the Nest App from the office or a business trip.
- In a meeting and unable to talk through the app? They can choose from a list of pre-recorded responses and Nest Hello will speak to their guest.



### Families

Families will love how it simplifies their lives and makes their home feel safer and more welcoming at the same time.

- They can use quiet time features to turn off the door chime when the kids are in bed or it's nap time.
- It works with Google Home Mini to sound an alert from their smart speaker. With Nest Aware it can use familiar face alerts to tell them who's at the door without checking a phone.
- The Nest Hello is designed for the front door. It has a 4:3 aspect ratio design to see a person from head to toe so they know who they're talking to.

## PRODUCT INTERACTIONS

### Nest x Yale Lock

Allows customers to remotely unlock their door when they see a friend (or delivery) through Nest Hello video doorbell.

### Google Assistant

Use Google Home as an additional door chime.

With a Nest Aware subscription and familiar face alerts, it will tell you who's at the door.

### Chromecast + Google Home

Cast the video to a Chromecast enabled device with a simple voice command to a Google Home or Google Home Mini.
